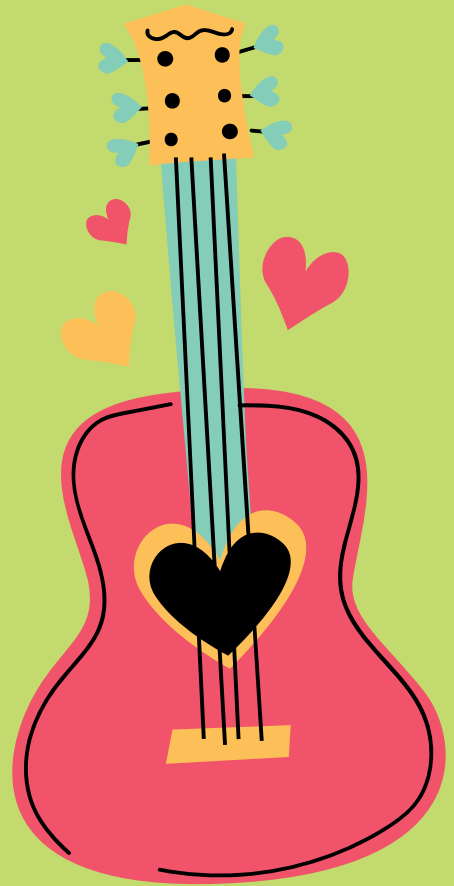

In addition, children will be authentically assessed through observation using Teaching Strategies GOLD.

Kid Connection is a child care program offered through Farmington Community Education. Kid Connection operates to support families in their child care needs, to give students enriching opportunities in out-of-school time, and to provide young people with opportunities for personal growth, social skill acquisition, recreation, and fun!

Kid Connection provides enhanced, choice-based, out-of-school-time activities before and after school, on non-school days and during the summer months. We are open Monday-Friday, from 6:00am until school starts for the day and again from the end of the school day until 6:00pm.

School Age Care (Kindergarten - 5th Grade) is available at all five elementary schools. Preschool Care is available at Meadowview Elementary, North Trail Elementary, Riverview Elementary, & The Tiger Legacy and Learning Center.

Be Cool, Follow the Rules!

At the Dodge Middle School Pool your safety is our highest priority. The head lifeguard has both the right and the responsibility to remove anyone not able or willing to comply with the pool rules. Some of the key rules are listed here. Additional rules are posted at the pool and are available upon request.

- Never enter the pool unless lifeguards are on duty.
- No running on the deck.
- Only dive from diving boards or starting block wall.
- No rough play.
- No prolonged underwater swimming or breath holding.

Lifeguard Whistles & Signals

- 1 or 2 short, sharp whistles = Stop & Look
- 3 (or more) long whistle blasts = everyone stop and get out

Pool Temperature

In accordance with our district's energy conservation plan, the temperature of the pool is set at 80° F for fall and winter lessons, and at 82° F for spring and summer lessons.

Summer Open Swim

Monday through Friday from June 10-Aug 9 (SKIP 6/19 & 7/1-7/5)

Open Swim Fees: \$5 per person (ages 3 and older)
Please pay someone in the pool office before swimming.
Children under age 8 and under must be with a parent or guardian.





AQAD: Adaptive lessons

This program provides a safe learning environment for students with mild disabilities and have an IEP with their school. Please contact the Aquatics Coordinator to discuss any special needs. This helps us prepare the most appropriate lessons possible.

AQAK: Aqua Kids (Parent/child)

This course is designed for children ages 2 to 4 that are new to swim lessons. Its purpose is to familiarize participants with the water and teach some swimming readiness skills. It is intended to get the children comfortable in a swimming pool atmosphere and get them interested and excited about coming to lessons on their own. An adult must be in the water with each student.

AQBP: Bobbers (Preschool)

This course is intended for 3 to 5 year olds that are new to swim lessons. It is similar to Aqua Kids but is for children that are able to participate without assistance from an adult. A Tot-Dock is used by the children to stand on during class.

AQL1: Level-1 (Introduction to Water Skills)



Orients students to the aquatic environment and helps them gain basic aquatic skills. Most skills are done with some support from either the instructor or some equipment.

Prerequisites: Comfortable in the water without adult assistance.

AQL2: Level-2 (Fundamental Aquatic Skills)



This course helps increase comfort and movement in the water with less support. Please bring goggles.

Prerequisites: Successfully demonstrate Level-1 skills.

NEW! AQL3.0 (Prep for L-3)

This is for those students that have "passed" Level-2 and are ready for more of a challenge, but just don't quite have the strength or endurance to safely participate in "regular" L-3 (renamed 3.1) yet. Please bring goggles.

Prerequisites: Successfully demonstrate Level-2 skills.

AQL3.1: Level-3 (Stroke Development)



This course takes place primarily in the deep end. Participants are working towards swimming across the pool on their own. Strokes include: front crawl, back crawl, elementary backstroke; and breaststroke and scissors kicks. Please bring goggles.

Prerequisites: Successfully demonstrate Level-2 skills and be ready to swim in the deep end.

AQL4: Level-4 (Stroke Improvement)



Participants start to become efficient in the water and learn turns at the wall. Strokes include: front crawl, back crawl, elementary backstroke, breaststroke, sidestroke, and the butterfly kick. Please bring goggles.

Prerequisites: Successfully demonstrate Level-3 strokes & skills.

AQL5: Level-5 (Stroke Refinement)



By this level, participants have learned all the strokes. They spend time improving efficiency and increasing endurance. Strokes include: front crawl, back crawl, elementary backstroke, breaststroke, sidestroke, and butterfly. Please bring goggles.

Prerequisites: Successfully demonstrate Level-4 strokes & skills.

AQL6: Level-6 (Fitness Swimming)



This course is ideal for participants that might be preparing for a competitive team or perhaps have completed Level-5 but are not able to take a/the lifeguarding course yet. Strokes will become as efficient as possible and they swim 500 yards nonstop. Please bring goggles.

Prerequisites: Successfully demonstrate Level-5 strokes & skills.

AQSP: Semi-Private Lessons

Students learn skills and strokes in smaller groups (typically just 1 or 2 per instructor). Once their "level" has been determined, they will work towards earning a passing certificate. Participants 14 years and older should call the pool office at 651-460-1515 to make special arrangements for lessons.
