2009 Fall Registration Information

The 2009 fall athletics season is right around the corner. This fall, the Farmington Athletics Department will offer the following athletics opportunities for prospective student-athletes: Boys' & Girls' Cross Country, Football, Boys' & Girls' Soccer, Girls' Swimming & Diving, Girls' Tennis, Girls' Volleyball, Co-ed Adapted Soccer, Strength & Conditioning, and Cheerleading. These fall athletics opportunities are available for student-athletes who will be in Grades 6-12 for the 2009-2010 academic school year. All student-athletes must be completely

registered prior to any athletics participation. The 2009-10 Farmington Athletics Registration Packet can be picked up at FHS, Robert Boeckman MS, Levi Dodge MS, or downloaded from the Farmington Athletics Website. The registration packet includes step-by-step instructions on athletics registration requirements. The Farmington Athletics Department will conduct a Fall Registration Night on Tuesday, August 4th at the new Farmington High School (20655 Flagstaff Avenue). This event will begin with a 6:00pm meeting for 6th, 7th, and 8th grade

student-athletes/parents and will be followed by a 7:00pm meeting for student-athletes/parents in Grades 9-12. Please note that 6th Grade student-athletes are eligible to participate in the following Middle School athletics programs in the 2009-2010 academic school year: Boys' & Girls' Cross Country, Girls' Swim & Dive, Girls' Tennis, Wrestling, and Boys' Tennis. Please note that 6th Grade student-athletes are only eligible to compete at the middle school level (No Varsity/JV/B-Squad/9th Grade competition).

As we approach the start of the 2009-2010 school year, Farmington Athletics will be offering separate middle school athletics programs at both Boeckman and Dodge Middle School in the following fall sport activities:

- FOOTBALL
- GIRLS' SOCCER
- VOLLEYBALL

Spectator Parking and Ticket Entrance Information

The following diagram/directions will assist you when coming to Farmington High School (20655 Flagstaff Avenue) for an athletics related event. This information focuses on parking, ticket entry, and traffic flow (when applicable). If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the Athletics Director.

INDOOR FARMINGTON HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS EVENTS:

1. Access Farmington HS via Flagstaff Avenue and enter site through either North or South Drive (NO parking allowed on either access drive).
2. Park in East Parking Lot and enter building through door #29 or door #30 (Indoor Athletics Ticket Entrance)

OUTDOOR FARMINGTON HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS EVENTS (Not Including Varsity Football):

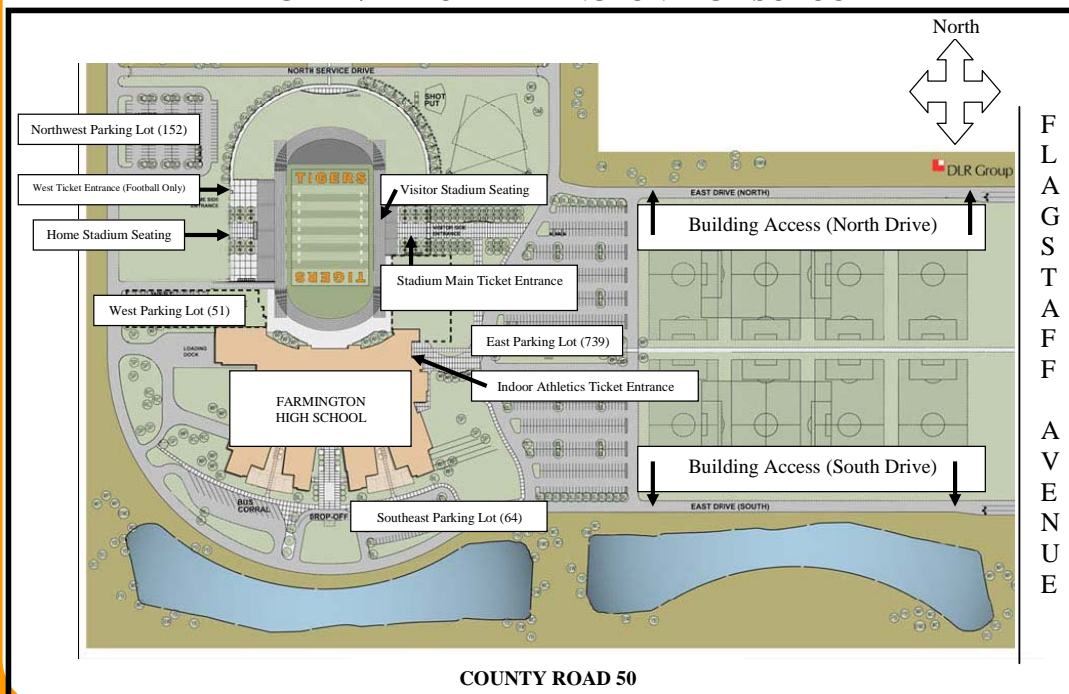
1. Access Farmington HS via Flagstaff Avenue and enter site through either North or South Drive (NO parking allowed on either access drive).
2. Park in East Parking Lot and access appropriate outdoor facilities: FHS Fields 1-8, Tiger Stadium, and Baseball/Softball Fields (North of Tiger Stadium).
3. If attending stadium event, please note that home spectator seating is on the West side of the stadium. You can access the home bleachers by entering main stadium ticket entrance and then following the paved path around the North end of the stadium.

VARSITY FOOTBALL EVENTS:

1. Access Farmington HS via Flagstaff Avenue and enter site through either North or South Drive (NO parking allowed on either access drive).
2. Parking will be available in four lots (East, Southeast, West, and Northwest). There will be NO parking allowed on the access roads that circle the building. Parking will be allowed in parking lots or other designated areas only.
3. Those parking in the East or Southeast lots will access ticketing through the east main stadium ticket entrance. Those parking in the West or Northwest lots will access ticketing through the west ticket entrance (West Ticket Entrance will be staffed at varsity football only).
4. If attending stadium event, please note that home spectator seating is on the West side of the stadium. If you enter facility through the east main stadium ticket entrance, you will then follow the paved path around the north end of the stadium to access home bleachers. The north hill will also be available for additional spectator seating.
5. At the completion of a varsity football game, all traffic must exit through the South Access Drive. The South Access Drive will be two lanes with the left lane (north lane) having to turn left and head north on Flagstaff and the right lane (south lane) having to turn right and head south on Flagstaff.

CHEERLEADING

The Varsity cheerleading squad will perform at all home and away Farmington varsity football games. The JV cheerleading squad will perform at all home Farmington JV and B-Squad games.

ADAPTED ATHLETICS

The Farmington School District offers both CI (Cognitively Impaired) and PI (Physically Impaired) Fall adapted soccer as a cooperative with the Lakeville, Burnsville, and New Prague School Districts. All Farmington school district students, grades 7-12, are eligible to participate in these programs. The Farmington Athletics Department does arrange transportation to and from practice sites. In addition, transportation is provided to home/away competition sites. If you have a student-athlete interested in participating in the adapted athletics program, please contact Jon Summer, Farmington Athletics Director, for registration information and requirements.

At the time of publication, fall adapted soccer schedules were not yet available.

Fall 2009 Middle School Athletics Program Expansion

The 2009-2010 school year will bring exciting change within ISD 192 and the Farmington Athletics Department. A new high school building that will service students grades 9-12 and two separate Middle School buildings (Dodge & Boeckman) that will each service students in grades 6-8. In an effort to continue to provide positive educational athletics experiences for the student-athletes in District 192, the Farmington Athletics Department will be providing separate athletics programming, in certain activities, at both Boeckman and Dodge Middle Schools. For example, prior to this fall 2009, the girls' soccer program provided middle school participation opportunities for 7th/8th Graders at two levels. Last fall, we had 67 girls register and participate, resulting in approximately 33 kids per team. This creates some challenges in our effort to provide the type of athletics experiences we want to offer. Thus, starting this fall 2009, we will offer two levels of middle school girls' soccer at both Boeckman and Dodge Middle Schools. Student-athletes will participate at the school they are attending. It is our plan to expand these middle school programs where we have had historically high participation numbers and where district athletics facilities will allow. Here is a breakdown of fall middle school athletics programs offerings and appropriate information for each of these programs. If you have questions or concerns about middle school athletics programs, please contact the Athletics Director.

MIDDLE SCHOOL ATHLETICS OFFERINGS

1. **BOYS' & GIRLS' CROSS COUNTRY:**

- A. There will be single middle school level for each gender. Most of the time, middle school participants will practice with high school participants. Coaching staff will communicate practice times/locations. Shuttle bus transportation will be provided for both Boeckman and Dodge student-athletes for practices held at Farmington High School.

2. **FOOTBALL:**

- A. There will be two levels of 7th Grade and two levels of 8th Grade provided at both Boeckman and Dodge Middle School. Students will participate with the school they attend. Practices will be held at the school they attend.

3. **BOYS' SOCCER:**

- A. There will be two levels of Boys' Soccer for a combined Boeckman/Dodge team. Coaching staff will communicate practice times/locations. Preliminary practice/game site will be Boeckman Middle School. A shuttle bus will provide after school transportation for Dodge student-athletes to Boeckman.

4. **GIRLS' SOCCER:**

- A. There will be two levels of middle school girls' soccer provided at both Boeckman and Dodge Middle School. Students will participate with the school they attend. Practices will be held at the school they attend.

5. **GIRLS' SWIM & DIVE:**

- A. There will be single middle school level for girls' swim & dive. Coaching staff will communicate practice times. All practices will be at Dodge Middle School. A shuttle bus will provide after school transportation for Boeckman student-athletes to Dodge.

6. **GIRLS' TENNIS:**

- A. There will be single middle school level for girls' tennis. Coaching staff will communicate practice times. All practices will be at Dodge Middle School. A shuttle bus will provide after school transportation for Boeckman student-athletes to Dodge.

7. **VOLLEYBALL:**

- A. There will be two levels of 7th Grade and two levels of 8th Grade provided at both Boeckman and Dodge Middle School. Students will participate with the school they attend. Practices will be held at the school they attend.
